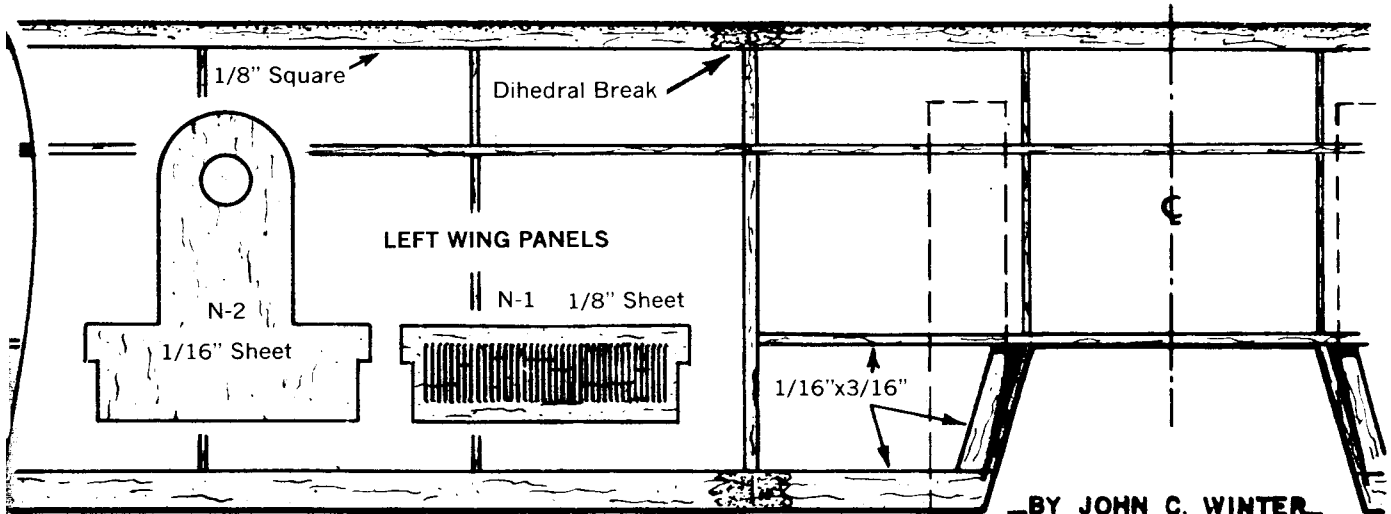
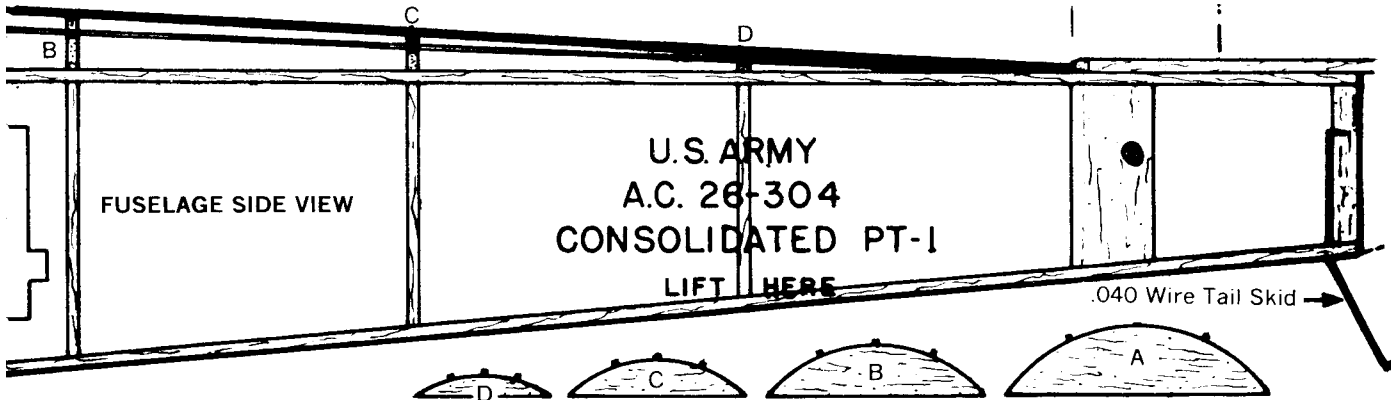
CONSOLIDATED PT-1 TRAINER

FULL SIZE DRAWINGS



COLORS: Fuselage olive drab. Wings and Tail are yellow. Rudder has red and white stripes with blue vertical stripe. Use 1930 period U.S. ARMY decals. Radiator and 1/4" square header tank are silver. Balance of engine dull black.

BALANCE: The PT-1 should balance on a point in line with the center of the front cockpit when balanced by the wing tips. Make minor trim adjustments as necessary to upper wing leading or trailing edge as required. See your local hobby dealer for needed components.
