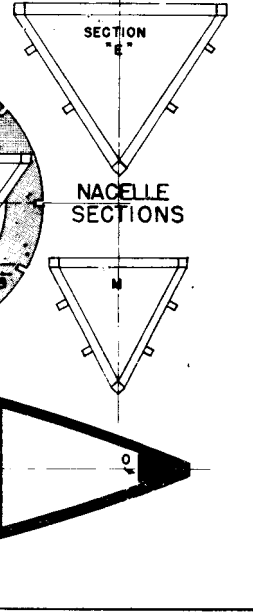


FUSELAGE

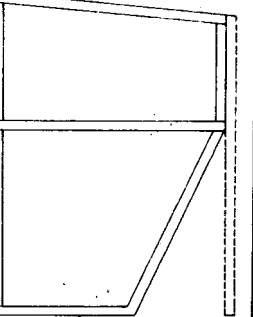




4. REAR HOOK: It is usually installed as illustrated. It is very important that you cement everything securely so that nothing pulls loose inside of your model.



5. TAIL ADJUSTMENT: The stabilizer is usually made separately in one piece. Omit to line you die the fuselage sides. Using specified strip unless for spare and rise, and the printed piece for curved parts. Adjust to null in the same way. Also parts are covered on both sides before installing on the model.



6. TO FLY: First balance the plane. If held at the center of its wing tips it should balance in a level position. If it does not, add weight to front or rear stabilizer and is lightest, until the model balances in level position. A thumb-nail or two should be in the ribs, if your model needs adjustment at all.

Wind your propeller about fifty times and gently launch your plane from your hand about four feet above the ground, pointing the nose of your model a few degrees downward. It should "zoom" smoothly gracefully to a smooth landing. However a few more adjustments may be necessary: if your model dives, bend your elevators up slightly, after supporting with your breath. If it stalls, bend tail down. Bend elevators down slightly. After making these adjustments and propeller about 100 times or more your plane will fly.

Fly your model in a grassy field or outdoors, or in a large hallway. Do not fly in a small room or over the damaged auto tire wheel.

We hope you have greatly enjoyed building this model and are proud of your accomplishment. Our comments are welcome and if you desire to and cooperate they will be combined with our usual appreciative interest.
